Sylvia Clark and her colleagues are licking their chops because they want a piece of the new \$18 million dollar taxpayer's pie. Quite simply, Planned Parenthood's illegal taxpayer supported abortion racket is looking to broaden its disguise and feed its fictitious propaganda machine.

Their disguise - appearing genuinely concerned about women's issues and unborn children, all the while taking our tax dollars to further their radical abortion agenda

and in turn feed distorted facts to Coloradans like a slick snake-oil salesman.

The fact is, Planned Parenthood has continued to flip their nose at the taxpayers of Colorado. In 1984 voters overwhelmingly passed Article 5, Section 50 of the Colorado Constitution, which clearly states, "No public funds shall be used - either directly or indirectly - for the performance of an induced abortion."

Yet, Colorado's largest abortion provider, advocate, and referral organization, Planned Parenthood, currently receives over \$1 million each year of the people's money. A recent independent auditors report of Planned Parenthood, obtained by Christian Coalition of Colorado through the Colorado Open Records Act, revealed that indeed Planned Parenthood is directly tied to abortion clinics all over Colorado.

Now they are salivating for more tax money. Scurrilously, the tax funded Planned Parenthood uses their money to support their "information" campaigns to defeat pro-family legislators, defeat pro-women's health ballot initiatives, dispense abortion-on-demand propaganda to the media, and

maintain their vast network abortion clinics and referral sites. There seems to be no end to the arrogance of Planned Parenthood as they desperately work to keep a tight fist around the people's tax dollars.

Who would give a dog a treat for performing a trick if they knew it was rabid?

The answer is easy in the case of an actual dog, but apparently much more deceiving when it comes to protecting babies from Planned Parenthood. It is important for Coloradans to understand that the odds on Planned Parenthood actually benefiting Colorado women, given their contemptuous abortion practices, are more astronomical than me taking home the Power Ball jackpot.

But Planned Parenthood doesn't want taxpayers to know the truth.
